Presentation 1

<u>Title</u>: The Covid-19 pandemic is causing structural change in tourism as an important part of the economy (case of Latvia).

Annotation: Tourism is endorsed by international global organizations as an important component of economic activity (OECD, 2014; UNWTO, 2018). Tourism also characterizes Latvia as an economically significant and valuable business activity. (Ministry of Economics of Latvia, 2019) The Covid-19 pandemic that spread in the spring of 2020 affected the tourism sector the fastest and most widely - a decrease in the number of tourists or linear negative trends was observed. However, the analysis of statistical data leads to the conclusion that at the same time and with even greater challenges, structural changes in tourism are developing as one of the components of the economic system, which requires innovative solutions for the revival of the tourism industry and successful sustainability.

Title: Consumer views towards the use of precision technologies in livestock farming.

Annotation: Precision Livestock Farming (PLF) as a management, monitoring and communication tool can improve animal health and welfare, facilitating rapid response to emerging problems. While technological innovations offer potential solutions throughout the value chain, the consumers' perceptions regarding such technological innovations have not been explored. The presentation reports consumers' needs, expectations, perception, fears, worries and benefits, regarding PLF solutions. The results highlight the importance of the transparency, reliability and trustworthiness of PLF information, and point out the prospects for product labelling.
